



- **(4) ICLO-NLS TEACHING SEMINAR**

The ICLO-NLS Teaching Seminar entitled ***True Psychoanalysis, and False*** begins this year. Jacques Lacan defined psychoanalysis as a praxis, namely, “to treat the real by the symbolic,” and also as a discourse, a new form of “social bond.” The end of an analysis, both its logical ending and its aim, is determined by and accounts for what it produced in its experience.

In the Lacanian Orientation, psychoanalysis is not psychotherapy. It is even the opposite to it. This does not mean that psychoanalysis is not applied in a variety of settings where its efficacy has been demonstrated. What is the mainspring of it? “What must there be in the analyst's desire for it to operate in a correct way?”

The questions of the formation of the analyst, the passage from analysand to analyst, the bond of the analyst to the School as subject, as well as the ‘neurotic fundament of the desire of the analyst’ -for each one-, will be put to work.

The Special Interest Group (SIG), *Child and Adolescent Lacanian Psychoanalysis* begins its 8<sup>th</sup> year of work.
